## **NOTICE OF RACE**

### **1.0 Rules**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the *2021-2024 Yachting New Zealand Racing Rules of Sailing*
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1, shall apply.
- 1.3 The Regatta will be run under Covid-19 rules for Traffic Light setting Orange. To enable the club to operate as normal as is possible Vaccine Passes will be required in the yacht club buildings and immediate surrounds.

### **2.0 Changes to Racing Rules**

- 2.1 For protests where only a Rule of Part 2 is alleged to have been broken an arbitration hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing.

### **3.0 Eligibility and Entry**

- 3.1 The WYC Roys Bay Regatta is open to all Dinghy, Catamaran, Etchells, Trailer Yachts classes, and Juniors (Optimist, P Class, Starling, Sunburst, Open BIC).
- 3.2 The Southern Laser Traveller Series will be sailed in conjunction with the WYC Roys Bay Regatta .
- 3.3 The Endurance Race on Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> is open to all Trailer yachts, Sports Boats and Etchells. The course will be set at a briefing on Sunday morning.
- 3.4 Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> will be a continuation of the Roys Bay Regatta for Lasers, Centre Boarders and Flying Fifteens with windward – leeward courses.
- 3.5 Sunday the 9th January will also be a reserve day if 3 races have not been completed for the New Year Regatta Etchell and Trailer Boat classes. Depending on number of races required to constitute a series the Endurance race may still be sailed.

3.6 Entries will be accepted at the Wanaka Yacht Club clubrooms from 1500hrs on Friday 7<sup>th</sup> January 2022

3.8 To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a financial member of a Yachting New Zealand affiliated club.

## **6.0 Racing Area**

Racing will be held on the waters of Lake Wanaka

## **7.0 Courses**

Courses will be advised at briefing.

## **8.0 Scoring**

8.1 The Low Point scoring system of Appendix A shall apply

8.2 3 races will be required to be completed to constitute a series

8.3 The New Year Regatta does not include the Endurance Races.

8.4 The NZ Freshwater Etchell Championships does not include the Endurance Races

## **9.0 Alternative Penalties**

For all Junior classes Rule 44.2 is changed so that the 720 degree turn is replaced by a 360 degree turn.

## **10.0 Safety**

10.1 Boats shall Sign In before going afloat and Sign Off after coming ashore on the entry and sign off sheet. Radio sign in/sign off will not be accepted.

10.2 A boat that retires from a race shall notify the race committee as soon as possible.

10.3 A boat or equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with relevant Safety Regulations

10.4 All Trailer Yachts and Etchells competing in the Endurance Race are required to carry a working VHF radio. A cell phone is not an acceptable alternative.

## **11.0 Disclaimer of Liability**

Competitors participate in races entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The Organising Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after racing.
